USER MANUAL

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY! BEFORE USING THE APPLIANCES
PLEASE KEEP IT HANDY FOR FUTURE USE!

PLEASE READ AND SAVE THESE IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

To ensure the best performance from your heater, please read and save the following instructions.

- Avoid installation behind a door.
- Use only the voltage specified on the rating plate of the heater.
- Do not cover or restrict airflow to the inlet or exhaust grilles in any manner as the appliance may overheat and become a fire risk (for Fan Heaters).
- Do not cover grilles, block entry or exhaust of airflow by placing appliance against any surface. Keep all objects at least 1 metre from the front and sides of the appliance. With exception of appliances designed for wall-mounting, maintain a 1 metre gap from the rear of the unit as well.

WARNING: FIRE RISK EXISTS IF THE HEATER IS COVERED BY OR POSITIONED CLOSE TO CURTAINS OR OTHER COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS

- Do not place appliance close to a radiant heat source.
- Do not operate in areas where gasoline, paint or other flammable liquids are used or stored.
- This appliance heats up when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. Switch off and use handles where provided when moving.
- Do not use the appliance to dry clothes.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended whilst in use.
- Do not insert or allow foreign objects enter any ventilation or exhaust opening, as this may cause an electric shock, fire or damage to the appliance.
- Do not immerse in liquid or allow liquid to run into the interior of the appliance, as this could create an electrical shock hazard.
- Do not use this appliance on a wet surface, or where it can fall or be pushed into water.
- Do not reach for an appliance that has fallen into water. Switch off at supply and unplug immediately.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord, plug or after the appliance malfunction or has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Return to a qualified electrical person for examination, electrical or mechanical adjustment, service or repair before further use.
- Do not operate appliance with wet hands.
- This appliance is intended for household use only and not for commercial or industrial use.

- Use this appliance only as described in this manual. Any other use is not recommended by the manufacturer and may cause fire, electric shock or injury.
- A common cause of overheating is deposits of dust or fluff in the appliance.
 Ensure these deposits are removed regularly by unplugging the appliance and vacuum-cleaning air vents and grilles, where available.
- Do not use this appliance in a window as rain may cause electric shock.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning products on this appliance. Clean with a damp cloth (not wet) rinsed in hot soapy water only. Always remove plug from the mains supply before cleaning.
- Do not connect the appliance to the mains source until it has been installed in its final location and adjusted to the position it will be used in.
- This appliance is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry or similar locations which may be exposed to water, moisture or humidity.
- Always operate on a flat horizontal surface.
- Switch off the appliance, then use handles (where provided) to change its position.
- Do not operate with the cord coiled up as this could cause a build up of heat, which could pose a hazard.
- The use of an extension cord with this appliance is not recommended.
- Do not remove the power plug from the socket by pulling the cord grip the plug instead.
- Always unplug appliance when not in use.
- Do not allow cord to come in contact with heated surfaces during operation.
- Do not run cord under carpeting, throw rugs or runners etc. Arrange cord away from areas where it is likely to be tripped over.
- Do not twist, kink or wrap the cord around the appliance, as this may cause the insulation to weaken and split. Always ensure that the cord has been fully removed from any cord storage area before use.
- Do not store appliance in a box or closed space until it has cooled down sufficiently.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the appliance.
- The appliance must not be located immediately below a socket-outlet.

- Do not use this appliance with a programmer, timer or any other device that switches the heater on automatically, since a fire risk exists if the appliance is covered or positioned incorrectly.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a qualified electrical person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not use this appliance outdoors, or on wet surfaces. Avoid spilling liquid on the appliance.
- In order to avoid a hazard due to inadvertent resetting of the thermal cutout, this
 appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a
 timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by the utility.
- For additional protection, the use of a Residual Current Device (RCD) with a tripping current not exceeding 30mA is recommended.
- Do not use this heater in the immediate surroundings of a bath, a shower or a swi mming pool.
- Do not use this heater if it has been dropped;
- Do not use if there are visible signs of damage to the heater;
- Use this heater on a horizontal and stable surface, or fix it to the wall, as applicable.
- WARNING: Do not use this heater in small rooms when they are occupied by persons not capable of leaving the room on their own, unless constant supervision is provided.
- WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, keep textiles, curtains, or any other flammable material a minimum distance of 1 m from the air outlet.

CLEANING/ MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS:

During Season Care:

- Before cleaning, be sure to turn off and unplug the heater.
- Carefully wipe the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Please be very cautious near the motor and heating elements.
- Do not immerse the heater in water.
- Never use gasoline, benzene or thinner. This will damage the surface of the heater.
- After cleaning, be sure to completely dry the unit with a cloth or towel.

After Season Care:

- Store heater in a cool and dry location with power cord properly secured.
- Please store the unit in its original carton or suitable container.


PRE—OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

• Carefully remove your heater from the box (please save the carton for off-season storage)

- This product requires the use of 220-240V~ 50Hz, 8A current above the power socket, please confirm the use.
- Place heater on a firm level surface.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

CONTROL PANEL



Plug the appliance into an appropriate electrical outlet. Turn on the appliance by pressing the main power switch to position "I". A beep sound will be heard and the power indicator will illuminate in the digital display. The appliance is in standby state.

- 1. Press " () " and the heater starts to work. Press the button again, the appliance will continue to work for 30 seconds (with countdown in the digital display) to fully dissipate heat and then turn to standby state.
- 2. Press" (M)" button enter into the mode selection, according to" high heat mode (HI light on) → low heat mode (LO light on) → ECO (ECO light on) → cold air mode (♣ light on). when once press in high mode, second press in low mode. High or low heat can not set the temperature, but display the ambient temperature.

Press third it into ECO mode, then Press + OR - to set required temperature . The default setting temperature is 25° C , and the temperature setting range is 10-35°C. After setting the ECO mode, the ambient temperature is displayed three seconds later.

The set temperature is linked to the ambient temperature. If the product is set to "30 ° C", when the ambient temperature is equal to or less than "28 ° C", the product's high-grade power heating work, when the ambient temperature is between "28 ° C to 30 ° C", the product works at a low level, when the ambient temperature is equal to or greater than "30 ° C", the product stops heating and continues to blow. If you want to select high or low heating function only, you can press the " button to cancel the ECO mode.

- 1. TIMER: Press " O " button, the "O" light on, continuously to set your desired timer from 1-12h. To cancel the timer function, keep pressing the timer button until the digital display shows "00"
- 4.Swing : Press" to activate swing function. Press it again to cancel.
- 5.In working state, press the " " key , the heater will continue to work for 30 seconds (so that the heating body can fully dissipate heat) before entering the standby state.
- 6. If the heater is not in use for a long time, unplug the power plug. If the heater is restarted, the display will show the last working condition. (product have no memory for timer function set. But it has memory for high/ Low. ECO. Cold wind and oscillation function.)
- 7. Screen off

Under high heat mode, low heat mode and ECO mode, the digital display (except for the power indicator and mode indicator) will extinguish automatically with no further operation in approx. 1 minute. Press any button again to recover.

OVERHEAT PROTECTION

This heater is protected with an overheat protection that switches off the appliance automatically in case of overheat, e.g. due to the total or partial obstruction of the grids. In this case, unplug the appliance, wait about 30 minutes for it to cool and remove the object which is obstructing the grids. Then switch it back on as described above. The appliance should operate normally. Should the problem persist, please contact the nearest customer service.

TIP-OVER PROTECTION

This heater is protected with a safety switch that turns off the appliance automatically when the heater falls over, or is at an excessive angle from the horizontal. This helps prevent accidents, and the heater will back to the standby mode when it is put back upright, press the buttons on control panel or remote control to reset the heater

Damage occurring to the equipment in the event of failure to do so will void this warranty.
