## **USER MANUAL**

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY! BEFORE USING THE APPLIANCES
PLEASE KEEP IT HANDY FOR FUTURE USE!

#### INTRODUCTION

- Before using your new heater, please carefully read through the following instructions. KEEP THIS BOOKLET IN A SAFE PLACE SO THAT YOU MAY CONSULT IT LATER.
- After removing the packaging, make sure that the appliance is in good condition.
- The packaging materials may contain plastic, nails etc., which may be hazardous and therefore should not be left within the reach of children.


#### IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Avoid installation behind a door.
- Use only the voltage specified on the rating plate of the heater.
- Do not cover or restrict airflow to the inlet or exhaust grilles in any manner as the appliance may overheat and become a fire risk (for Fan Heaters).
- Do not cover grilles, block entry or exhaust of airflow by placing appliance against any surface. Keep all objects at least 1 metre from the front and sides of the appliance. With exception of appliances designed for wall-mounting, maintain a 1 metre gap from the rear of the unit as well.

### WARNING: FIRE RISK EXISTS IF THE HEATER IS COVERED BY OR POSITIONED CLOSE TO CURTAINS OR OTHER COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS

- Do not place appliance close to a radiant heat source.
- Do not operate in areas where gasoline, paint or other flammable liquids are used or stored.
- This appliance heats up when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. Switch off and use handles where provided when moving.
- Do not use the appliance to dry clothes.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended whilst in use.
- Do not insert or allow foreign objects enter any ventilation or exhaust opening, as this may cause an electric shock, fire or damage to the appliance.
- Do not immerse in liquid or allow liquid to run into the interior of the appliance, as this could create an electrical shock hazard
- Do not use this appliance on a wet surface, or where it can fall or be pushed into water.
- Do not reach for an appliance that has fallen into water. Switch off at supply and unplug immediately.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord, plug or after the appliance malfunction or has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Return to a qualified electrical person for examination, electrical or mechanical adjustment, service or repair before further use.
- Do not operate appliance with wet hands.
- This appliance is intended for household use only and not for commercial or industrial use.
- Use this appliance only as described in this manual. Any other use is not recommended by the manufacturer and may cause fire, electric shock or injury.
- A common cause of overheating is deposits of dust or fluff in the appliance. Ensure these deposits are removed regularly by unplugging the appliance and vacuum-cleaning air vents and grilles, where available.
- Do not use this appliance in a window as rain may cause electric shock.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning products on this appliance. Clean with a damp cloth (not wet) rinsed in hot soapy water only. Always remove plug from the mains supply before cleaning.
- Do not connect the appliance to the mains source until it has been installed in its final location and adjusted to the
  position it will be used in.
- This appliance is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry or similar locations which may be exposed to water, moisture or humidity.

- · Always operate on a flat horizontal surface.
- Switch off the appliance, then use handles (where provided) to change its position.
- Do not operate with the cord coiled up as this could cause a build up of heat, which could pose a hazard.
- The use of an extension cord with this appliance is not recommended.
- Do not remove the power plug from the socket by pulling the cord grip the plug instead.
- Always unplug appliance when not in use.
- Do not allow cord to come in contact with heated surfaces during operation.
- Do not run cord under carpeting, throw rugs or runners etc. Arrange cord away from areas where it is likely to be tripped over.
- Do not twist, kink or wrap the cord around the appliance, as this may cause the insulation to weaken and split. Always
  ensure that the cord has been fully removed from any cord storage area before use.
- Do not store appliance in a box or closed space until it has cooled down sufficiently.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental
  capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction
  concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the appliance.
- The appliance must not be located immediately below a socket-outlet.
- Do not use this appliance with a programmer, timer or any other device that switches the heater on automatically, since a fire risk exists if the appliance is covered or positioned incorrectly.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a qualified electrical person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not use this appliance outdoors, or on wet surfaces. Avoid spilling liquid on the appliance.
- In order to avoid a hazard due to inadvertent resetting of the thermal cutout, this appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by the utility.
- For additional protection, the use of a Residual Current Device (RCD) with a tripping current not exceeding 30mA is recommended.




- 1. Air outlet

#### **OPERATION**

Before inserting the plug into an electrical outlet, make sure that the electrical supply in your area matches that on the rating label on the unit.



#### **POWER AND HEAT SETTINGS**

S	Fan without Heater
1	Fan with low Heater
2	Fan with high Heate

#### **THERMOSTAT**

Set the thermostat to "max." and operate the appliance until the desired room temperature is reached. Turn the thermostat anticlockwise until the appliance switches off with an audible "click".

This set temperature will be kept almost constant by the appliance switching on and off automatically.

Please note that the appliance does not switch on unless the thermostat setting is higher than the room temperature.

#### **OVERHEAT PROTECTION**

This heater is protected with thermal cutoff protection that switches off heating automatically in case of severe overheating. eg. something covering the heater. In this case, waiting to the appliance cool and removing the objects. Then the thermal cutoff will automatically reset, heating as normally. Check for damage to the appliance, the cord and the plug. If there is no damage, plug the unit back in and switch it on as described above. If the heater still does not turn on, please contact Customer Service for assistance.

#### **CLEANING & MAINTENANCE**

- Before undertaking any cleaning or maintenance on the appliance, disconnect it from the power supply.
- For cleaning it is recommended to use a soft moist rag and neutral detergent. Do not use an abrasive cloth or devices which could affect the appearance of the appliance. Check that the hot air outlet and the ventilation inlet are free of dust and dirt. During cleaning, be careful not to touch the heating elements.
- In case of breakdown and/or poor functioning of the appliance, disconnect the appliance from the power supply and contact an authorised repairer.

VON provides a 12 months warranty for this product from the date of purchase.

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

- 1 The warranty is valid for 12 months from the date of purchase.
- 2 This card must be completed and returned for registration of the promised warranty to M/S Hotpoint Appliances Ltd within two weeks of purchase, failing to which this warranty will be deemed to be null and void.
- 3 Warranty is given that the product recorded above is free from factory faults and any defect which in our judgment is due to manufacturing will be serviced free-of-charge and faulty part(s) will be replaced, not the product. This warranty is a quality assurance warranty and applicable for repairs and service as stated. This is not a replacement warranty.
- 4 All customers are strongly advised to protect their equipment from damaging power surges and dips with the recommended voltage stabilizers. Damage occurring to the equipment in the event of failure to do so will void this warranty. All products must be installed correctly according to the instructions stated in the manual and must be used solely for purposes intended/designed. Electrical damage caused by power supply other than the specified voltage and cautions will not be covered by this warranty. Similarly, damage caused by lightening /power surges/ transformers/ high voltage will not be covered by this warranty.
- **5** This warranty applies only to VON branded products that have been purchased within Kenya from either M/S Hotpoint Appliances Ltd or any of our authorized dealers.
- 6A This warranty does not cover plastic parts, ordinary wear and tear, tampering and repairs undertaken by unauthorized sources without prior permission of M/S Hotpoint Appliances Ltd, negligence or accident or cases where original serial number of the product purchased has been altered or erased or removed.
- **6B** This warranty does not cover accidental damages, misuse or abuse, to the cabinet parts, knobs or consumable items such as batteries, belts, bulbs, glass, trays, taps, and others.
- **6C** This warranty will be rendered invalid if the item is misused/tampered and or damaged by an unauthorized individual/institute during delivery, installation or repair.

- 7 Damage/fault caused by insects/pests is also not covered by this warranty.
- 8 This warranty does not cover any transport related charges/costs to attend/deliver/collect any malfunctioning product. However, the return will be provided at no cost/charge if the item is under warranty and requires to be returned to the end user.
- 9 No alteration will be accepted made on the warranty card as far as the model, serial numbers and the date is concerned
- 10 In case of the item being exchanged, this warranty card must be surrendered in exchange for another one.
- 11 Any warranty claim must be accompanied with this warranty card; no claim would be accepted whatsoever without the original warranty card.
- 12 Hotpoint Appliances Ltd shall endeavor in its best ability to repair within 48 (forty-eight) hours, subject to availability of manufacturer's recommended genuine parts. Should the said spares be not available, then in that event Hotpoint Appliances shall be absolved from its responsibility as this event shall be deemed as a Force Majeures.
- 13 The purchaser agrees that the sole liability of Hotpoint Appliances Ltd with respect to defective goods shall be limited as set forth in this warranty and Hotpoint Appliances Ltd shall not be liable under any theory of relief, including breach of contract, negligence, strict liability, tort or otherwise for incidental consequential or other damages including but not limited to loss of profits, injury to property, or loss of use of the goods. In no event shall the liability of Hotpoint Appliances Ltd hereunder exceed the purchase price actually paid by purchaser for the goods. The foregoing warranty is in lieu of all the other expenses and implied warranties including, without limitation, warranties of merchantability and fitness for purpose.
- 14 This warranty shall be subject to the Laws of Kenya.
