

- The packaging materials may contain plastic, nails etc., which may be hazardous and therefore should not be left within the reach of children.


IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Avoid installation behind a door.
- Use only the voltage specified on the rating plate of the heater.
- Do not cover or restrict airflow to the inlet or exhaust grilles in any manner as the appliance may overheat and become a fire risk (for Fan Heaters).
- Do not cover grilles, block entry or exhaust of airflow by placing appliance against any surface. Keep all objects at least 1 metre from the
 front and sides of the appliance. With exception of appliances designed for wall-mounting, maintain a 1 metre gap from the rear of the unit
 as well


• Do not place appliance close to a radiant heat source.


- Do not operate in areas where gasoline, paint or other flammable liquids are used or stored.
- This appliance heats up when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. Switch off and use handles where provided when moving.
- · Do not use the appliance to dry clothes.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended whilst in use.
- Do not insert or allow foreign objects enter any ventilation or exhaust opening, as this may cause an electric shock, fire or damage to the
 appliance.
- . Do not immerse in liquid or allow liquid to run into the interior of the appliance, as this could create an electrical shock hazard.

- Do not use abrasive cleaning products on this appliance. Clean with a damp cloth (not wet) rinsed in hot soapy water only. Always remove
 plug from the mains supply before cleaning.
- . Do not connect the appliance to the mains source until it has been installed in its final location and adjusted to the position it will be used in.
- · This appliance is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry or similar locations which may be exposed to water, moisture or humidity.
- · Always operate on a flat horizontal surface.
- Switch off the appliance, then use handles (where provided) to change its position.
- Do not operate with the cord coiled up as this could cause a build up of heat, which could pose a hazard.
- The use of an extension cord with this appliance is not recommended.
- Do not remove the power plug from the socket by pulling the cord grip the plug instead.
- · Always unplug appliance when not in use.
- Do not allow cord to come in contact with heated surfaces during operation.
- Do not run cord under carpeting, throw rugs or runners etc. Arrange cord away from areas where it is likely to be tripped over.
- Do not twist, kink or wrap the cord around the appliance, as this may cause the insulation to weaken and split. Always ensure that the cord has been fully removed from any cord storage area before use.
- Do not store appliance in a box or closed space until it has cooled down sufficiently.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the appliance.
- The appliance must not be located immediately below a socket-outlet.
- Do not use this appliance with a programmer, timer or any other device that switches the heater on automatically, since a fire risk exists if
 the appliance is covered or positioned incorrectly.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a qualified electrical person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not use this appliance outdoors, or on wet surfaces. Avoid spilling liquid on the appliance.
- In order to avoid a hazard due to inadvertent resetting of the thermal cutout, this appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by the utility.
- For additional protection, the use of a Residual Current Device (RCD) with a tripping current not exceeding 30mA is recommended.



OPERATION AND DISPLAY

REMOTE CONTROL





- 1. Before inserting the plug into an electrical outlet, make sure that the electrical supply in your area matches that on the rating label on the unit.
- 2. Carefully remove the heater from the plastic bag and the carton.
- 3. Place the heater on a firm level surface
- 4. Setting the master button to "off".plug the cord set into a 220-240v~AC electrical outlet.Turnning the master button "on" position.
- 5. Turn the heater ON by pressing the main button at the back side of the heater. The unit will display the current Room

temperature.

- 6. And then by pressing the " button,the unit will low heating working .
- 7. You can press the control button " on the body or the" button on the remote control to choose mode .The heater in the order of "2 low heating -3 high heating-1 fan" in circle and the display screen displays the current mode(heating icon is not displayed during fan mode)
- 8. Press the " button on the body control button or the " and " buttons on the remote control to enter the temperature setting mode. The default setting temperature is 25 °C, and the temperature setting range is 10-35 °C. After setting the temperature, the heater intelligently selects the heating mode for operation. When the ambient temperature reaches the set temperature, the product stops heating; When the ambient temperature is lower than the set temperature, the product starts heating mode. If you want to select a specific heating mode, you can press the" button to cancel the temperature setting mode; After setting, switch to the current mode within 3 seconds.
- 9. pressing " on the body control panel or on the remote control ,you can set the timer from 0-12 hours. - 1 The warranty is valid for 12 months from the date of purchase.
- 2 This card must be completed and returned for registration of the promised warranty to M/S Hotpoint Appliances Ltd within two weeks of purchase, failing to which this warranty will be deemed to be null and void.
- 3 Warranty is given that the product recorded above is free from factory faults and any defect which in our judgment is due to manufacturing will be serviced free-of-charge and faulty part(s) will be replaced, not the product. This warranty is a quality assurance warranty and applicable for repairs and service as stated. This is not a replacement warranty.
- 4 All customers are strongly advised to protect their equipment from damaging power surges and dips with the recommended voltage stabilizers. Damage occurring to the equipment in the event of failure to do so will void this warranty. All products must be installed correctly according to the instructions stated in the manual and must be used solely for purposes intended/designed. Electrical damage caused by power supply other than the specified voltage and cautions will not be covered by this warranty. Similarly, damage caused by lightening /power surges/ transformers/ high voltage will not be covered by this warranty.
